

Thal Boarding & Training, LLC Rules

- **Waivers Required.** All boarders, handlers and riders (parent/guardian if under 18) must sign a waiver before handling a horse. **Waivers are located in the red box in the adobe barn – put signed waivers in “Notes” bin.** Boarders, handlers and riders are responsible for any damages or injuries caused by negligent horse handling or behavior.
- **Barn Etiquette.** Please pick up any trash, manure, hair, etc.. left by you or your horse and put it in the muck buckets or trashcans.
- **Horsemanship.** At all times, please display safe horsemanship skills when handling horses. No inappropriate behavior toward horses is tolerated. Do not disturb or feed other people’s horses.
- **Helmets & Proper Footwear Required.** Helmet & boots or hard sole shoes with heel required when mounted.
- **Boarding & Lessons.** Only horses boarded with Thal Boarding (or here for veterinary work) are allowed a stall. If you bring your horse for a lesson, please bring your own water bucket & other equipment and tie at trailer or appropriate rails. Please park trailer on north side of indoor arena.
- **Trail Riding.** Stay on the trail, *please do not ride freely across the unmarked areas out back.*
- **Security.** If you open a gate or door, close and latch it, as appropriate. Please close & lock tack room if you are the last to leave at the end of the day.
- **Vices.** Please enjoy elsewhere. No smoking, alcohol or drug use permitted on the property.
- **Children & Dogs.** We love them. Nevertheless, children shall be under adult supervision at all times and please keep dogs in your vehicle at all times.
- **Drive Slowly.** The speed limit is **5 MPH**. Vehicles are only to be driven on marked roads.
- **Landscaping.** *Please do not drive or put horses on areas of landscaping, trees or grass.*
- **Thal Equine.** Please remember that there is a veterinary clinic on the premises and:
 - To the extent practicable, it is Thal Equine’s policy to maintain confidentiality regarding its medical cases. We ask that you respect that policy when you see or hear of a Thal Equine patient.
 - Thal Equine makes reasonable efforts to ensure privacy regarding its medical cases. Nevertheless, please understand that it may not be possible to shield you from seeing this work.
 - Please do not enter the Hospital Barn or the medical facilities without prior consent from Dr. Thal or his staff. Please pass by these areas slowly and with caution so as not to disturb the horses.
